Principles:

- Focus on priority-setting for 2008/09 Research Call for Proposals
- Expand First Nations Advisory Group (FNAG) to identify FN priorities
- Assign 2 FNAG members to each research PAC (SPAC, TPAC)

Focus on priority-setting for 2008/09 Research Call



Step 1: FNAG identifies FN research priorities

Step 2: FNAG representatives participate in SPAC and TPAC priority-setting

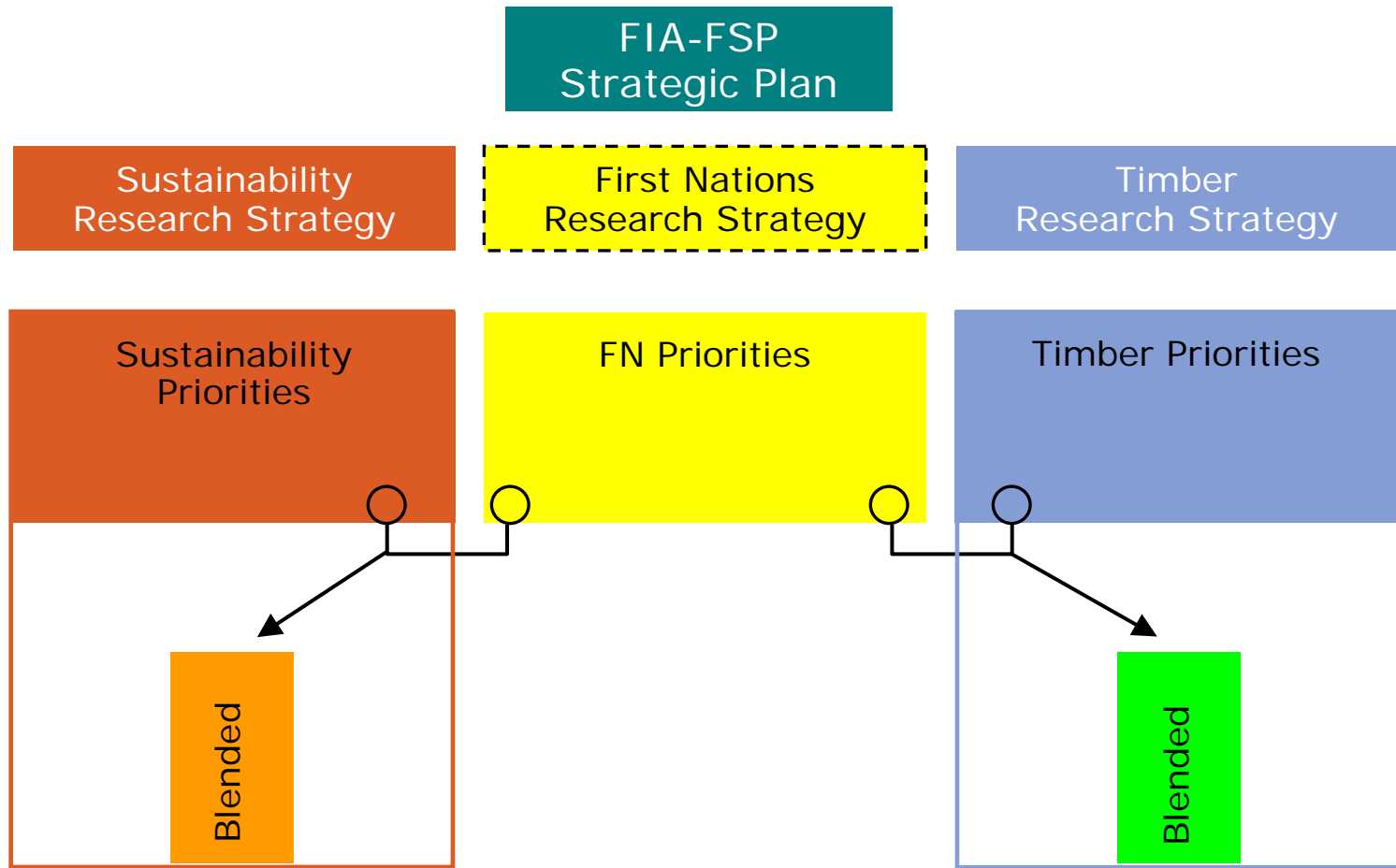
Identify common priorities



Step 3: S/TPACs review First Nations research priorities in consideration of existing S/TPAC priorities

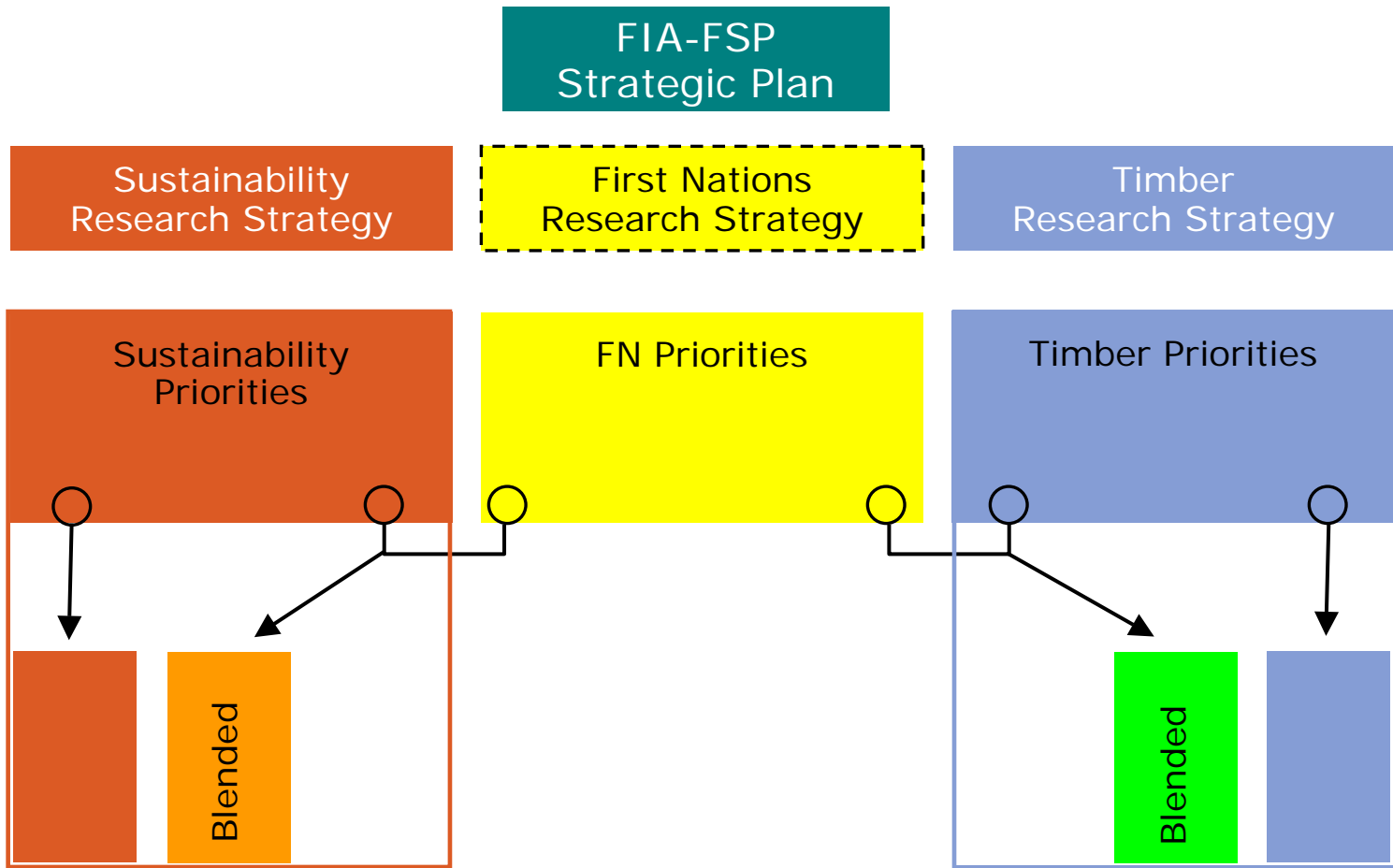
FIA-FSP First Nations Harmonization

Reword common priorities to include FN interests



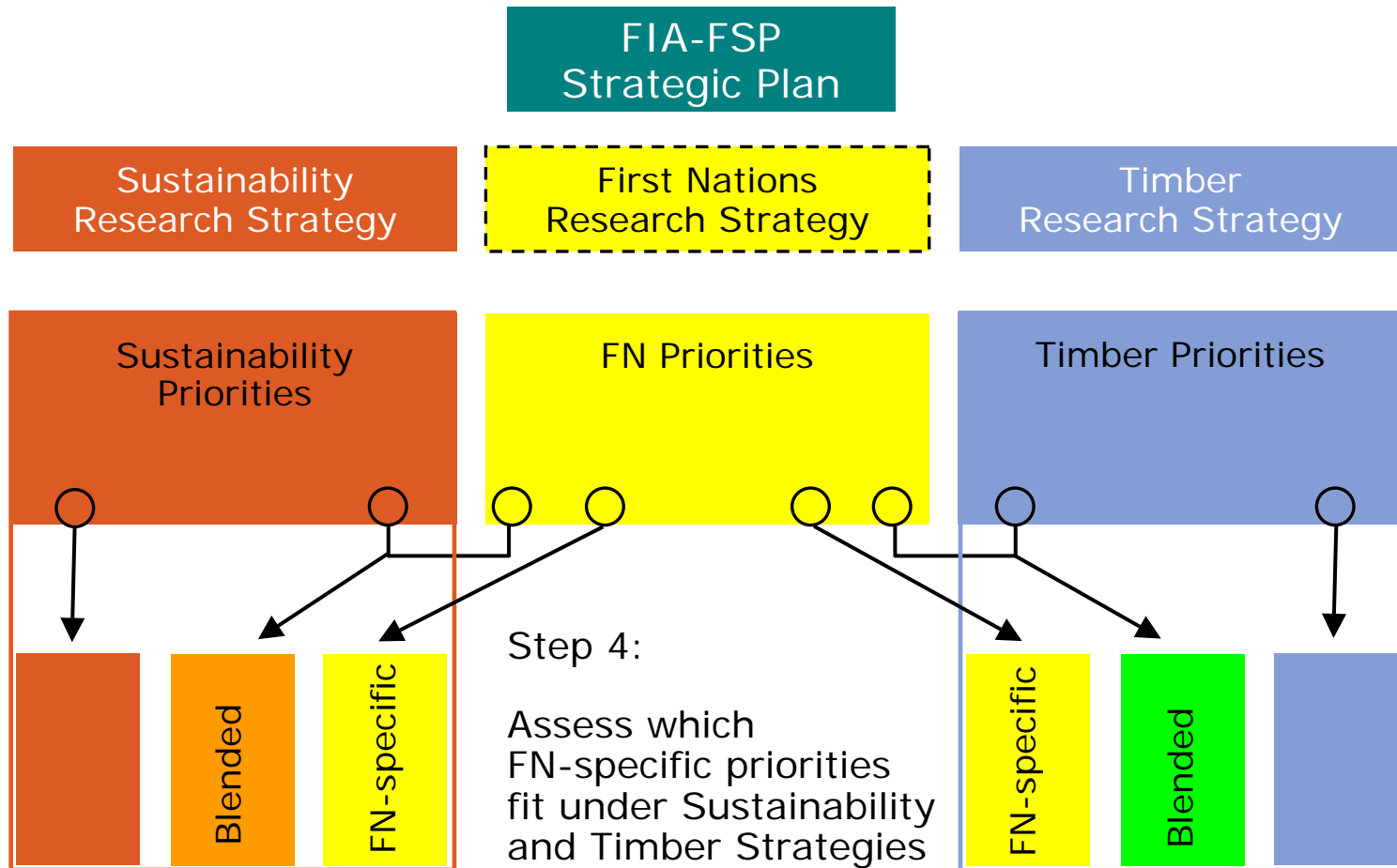
FIA-FSP First Nations Harmonization

Some existing PAC priorities may not be FN priorities



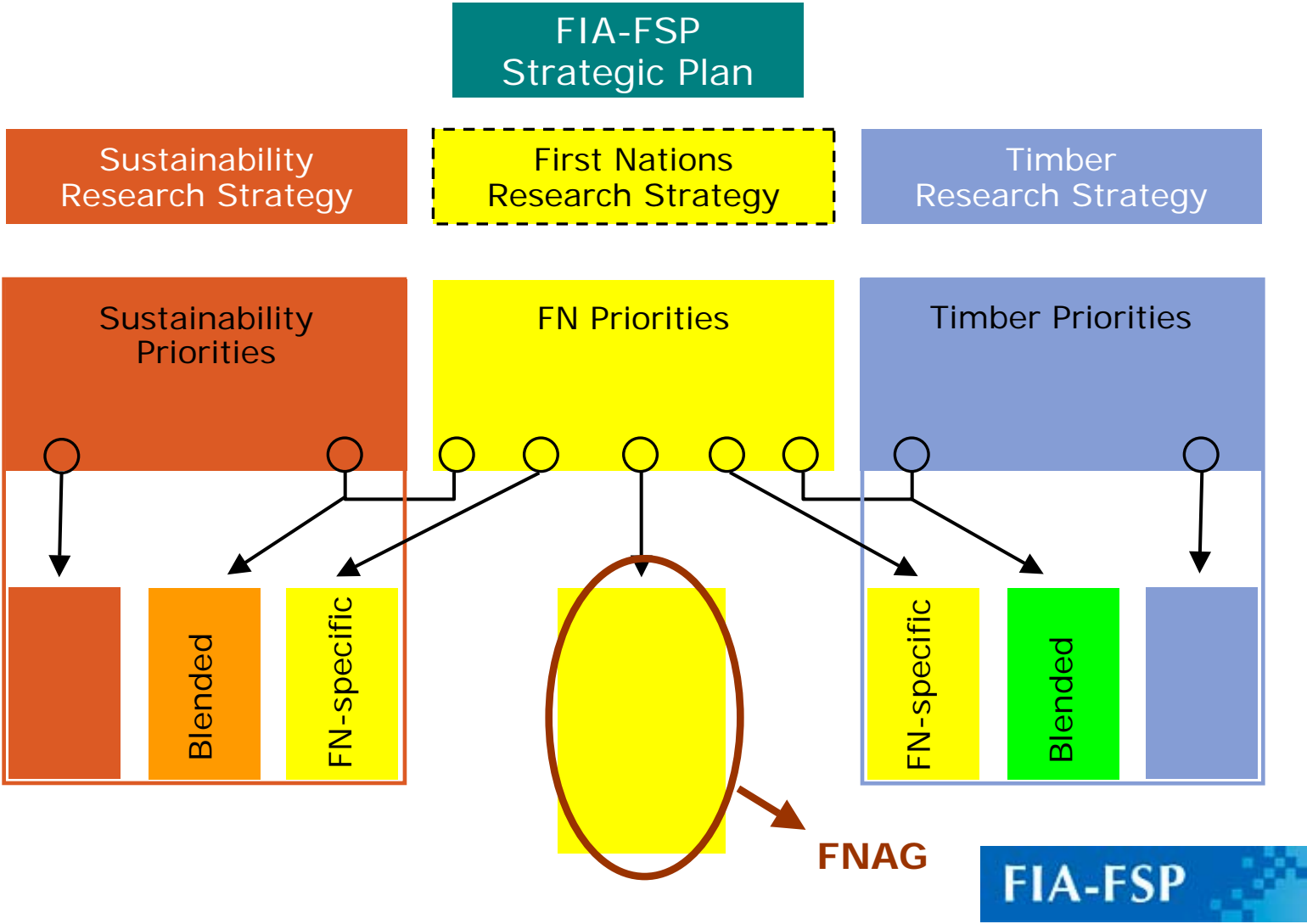
FIA-FSP First Nations Harmonization

Some FN priorities may require new topics or themes



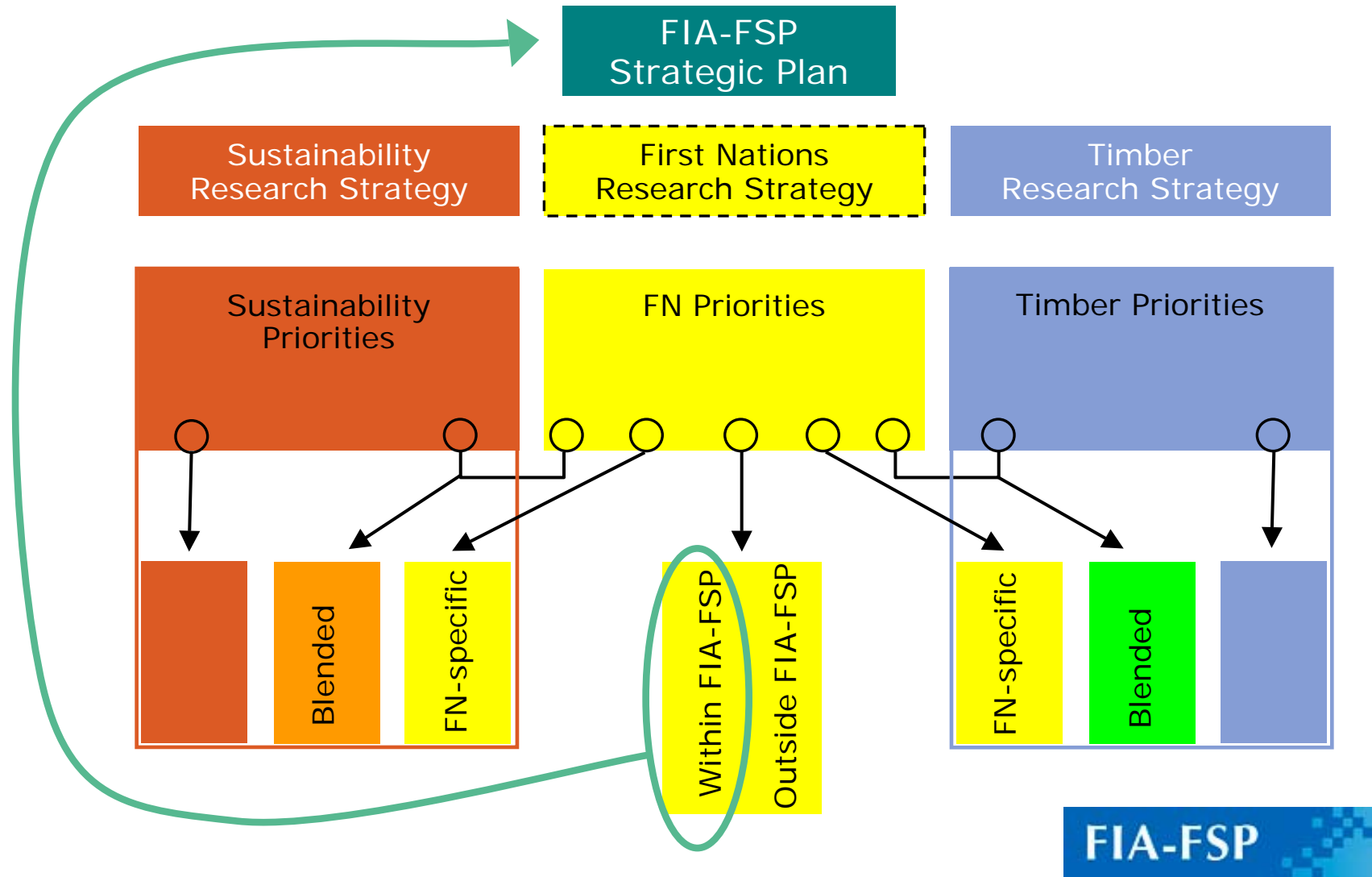
FIA-FSP First Nations Harmonization

FN priority appears to be outside Sustainability or Timber scope, refer to FNAG for clarification



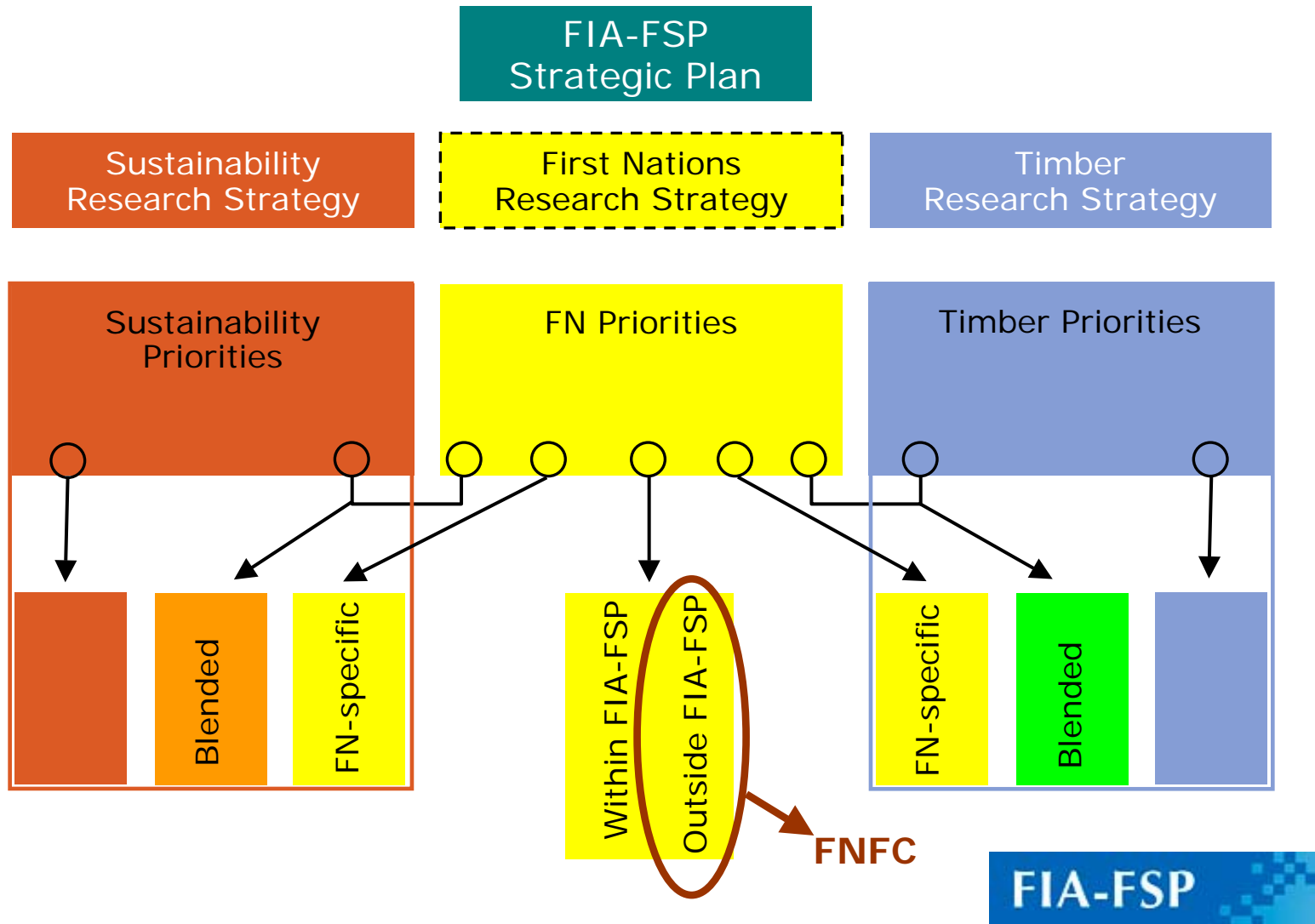
FIA-FSP First Nations Harmonization

FN priority is within FIA-FSP scope, but outside Sustainability or Timber strategies, refer to FSB



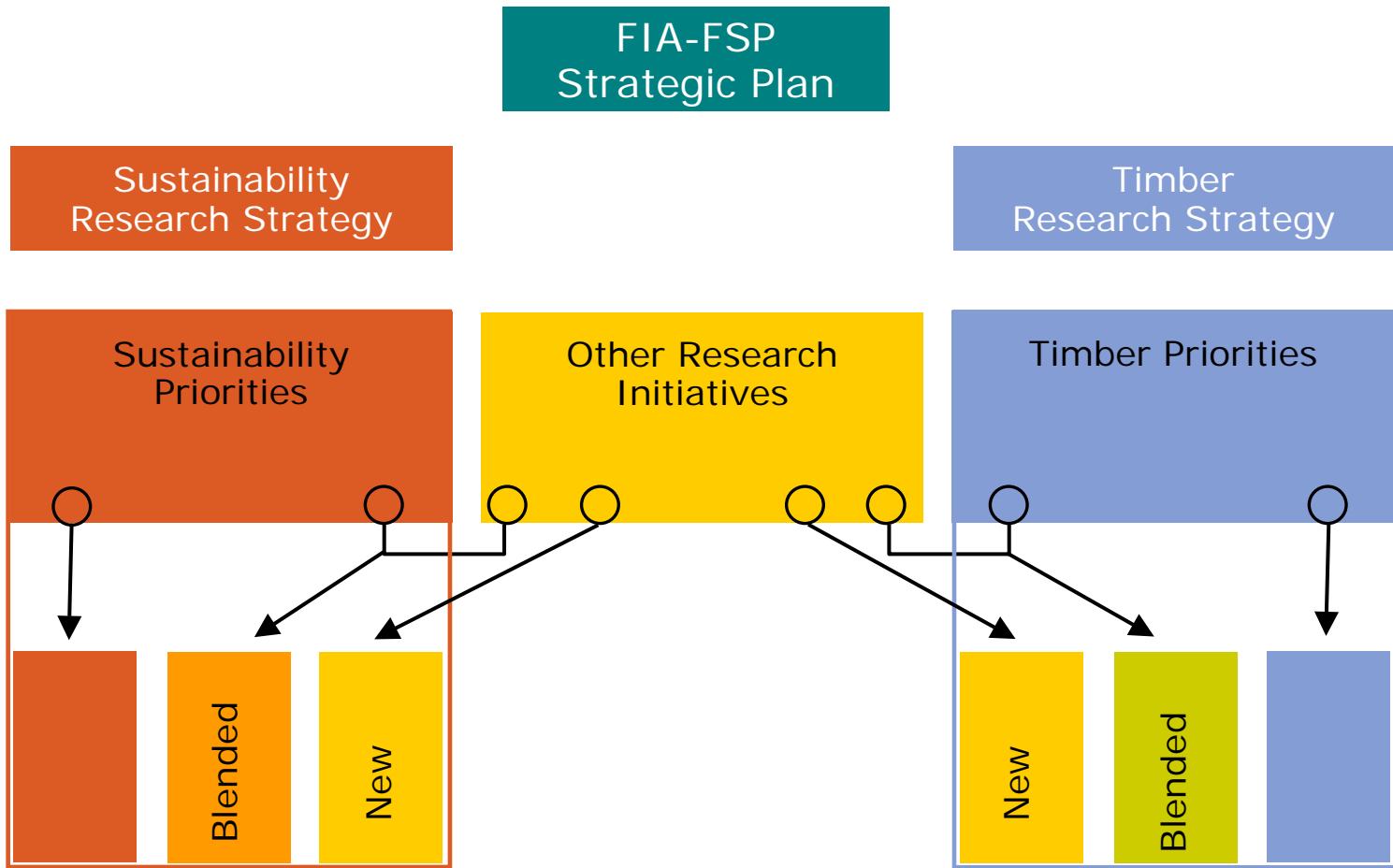
FIA-FSP First Nations Harmonization

FN priority is outside FIA-FSP scope, refer to FNFC



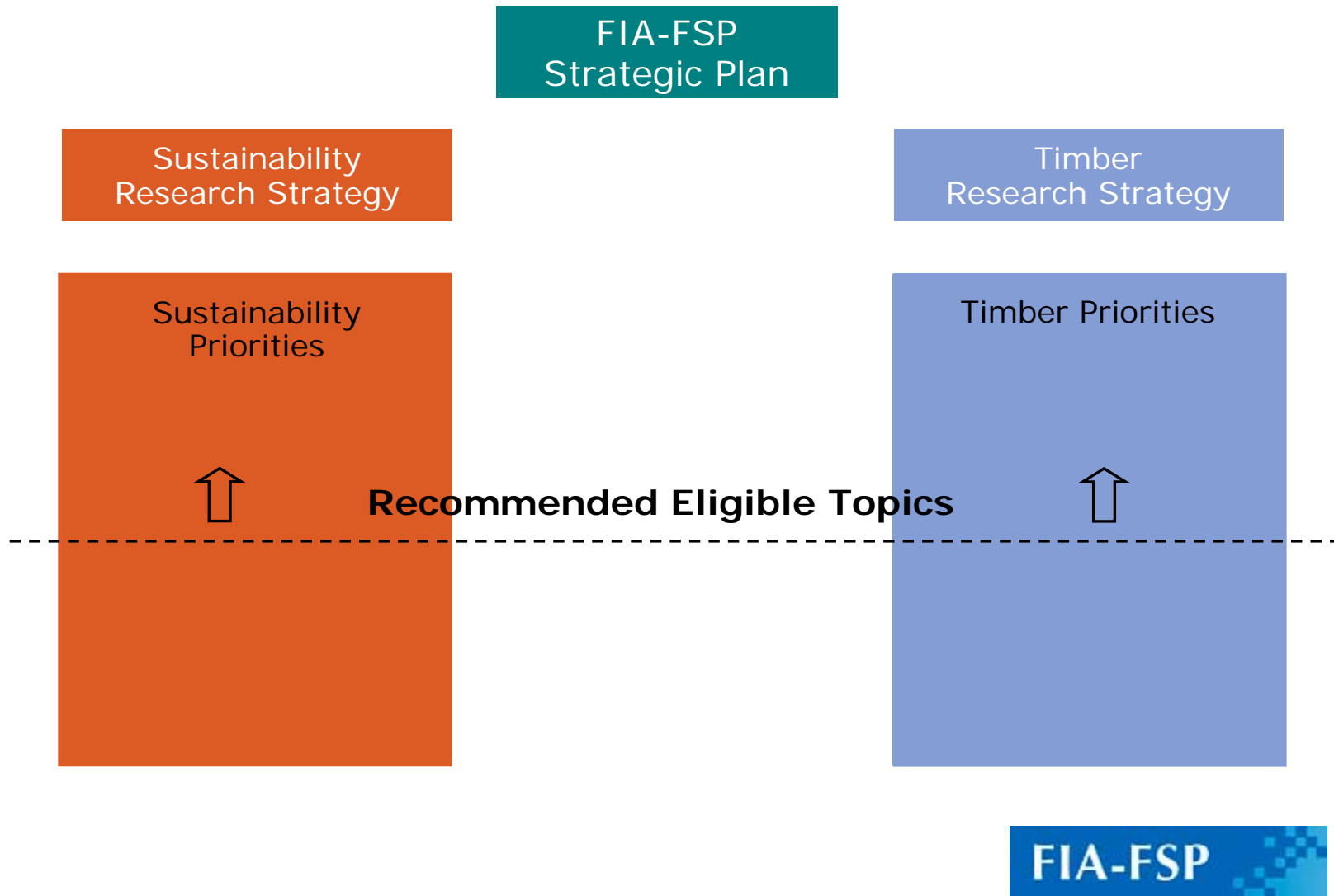
FIA-FSP First Nations Harmonization
